AGE provides transportation for their members between AGE Adult Day Centers and the member's homes. AGE operates Adult Day Centers in Travis and Williamson Counties.

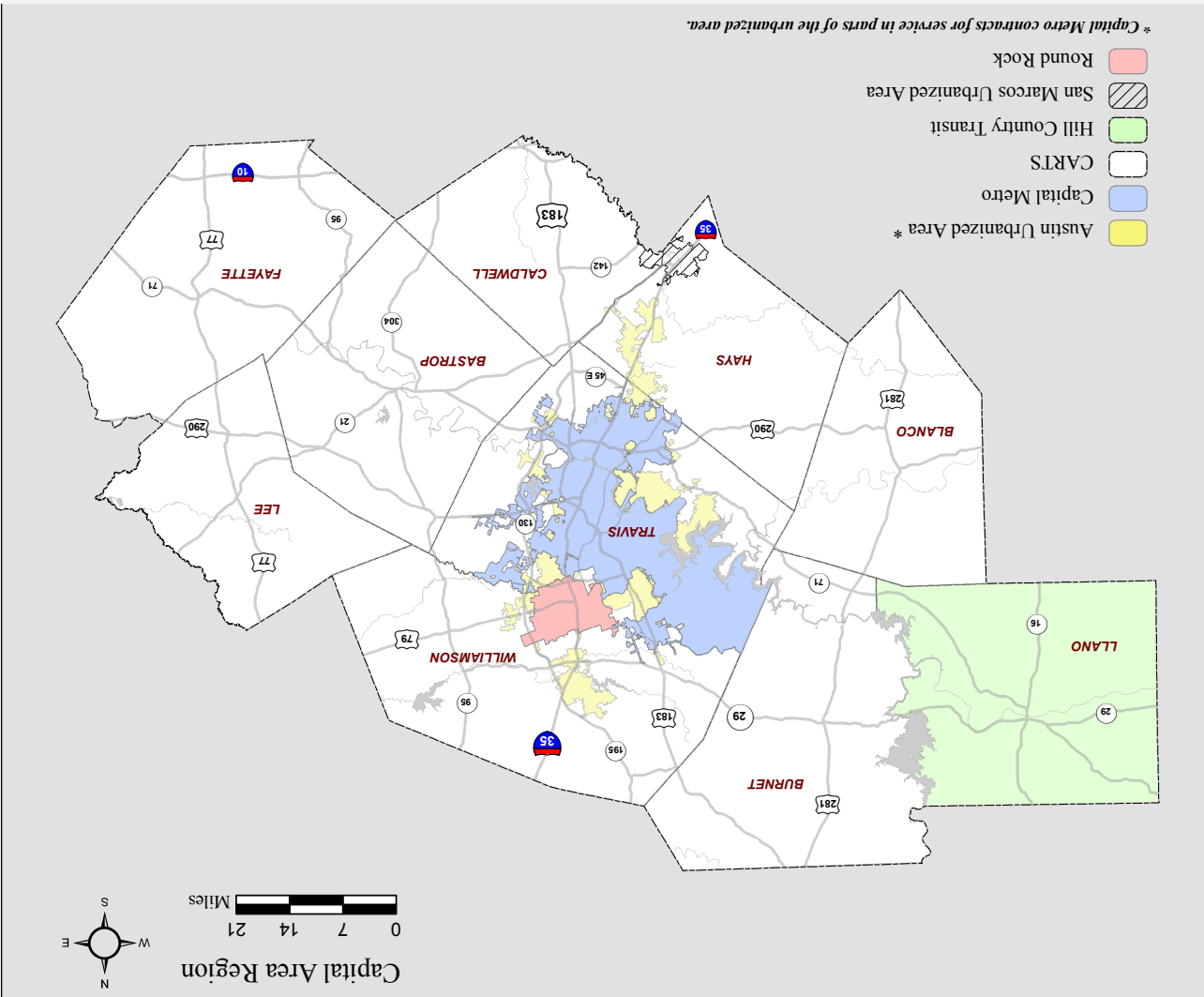

THE HOP

The HOP is operated by Hill Country Transit District and provides curb-to-curb and non-emergency medical transportation services in Llano County. Transit services are also provided in counties outside the Capital Area, including Hamilton, Lampasas, Mason, Milam, Mills, San Saba, Bell and Coryell counties.

CAPITAL AREA RURAL TRANSPORTATION SYSTEM

CARTS provides public transportation for the rural areas of Central Texas, including Bastrop, Blanco, Burnet, Caldwell, Fayette, Hays, Lee and parts of Travis and Williamson Counties. CARTS offers a variety of services, including curb-to-curb service, regional intercity routes, fixed routes in San Marcos and Bastrop, connectors to Capital Metro, commuter routes, and access to national train and bus services.

Capital Metro provides public transportation in Austin, Jonestown, Lago Vista, Leander, Manor, Point Venture, San Leanna, Volente, and parts of Travis and Williamson Counties. Capital Metro offers a variety of services, including Local and Express bus, rail, rideshare and paratransit services. Capital Metro also provides free, personalized travel training to seniors and people with disabilities. Training ranges from instruction on how to travel specific routes for work, doctor's appointments and recreation, to utilizing the entire bus system.
